15 INITIAL INCIDENT DESCRIPTION / NARRATIVE:
[On November 30, 2016, I responded to a fight disturbance call at N 45 St and Woodlawn Pl N. The call showed, "IN ROAD. 2 MALES IN PHYSICAL NO WPNS SEEN." The suspect was described as, "BM, 12YOA, BLK SWEATER, WHI T SHIRT, CAMO PANTS." As I was approaching the call location I observed a black male who matched the description walking westbound on N 45 St. I knew the subject from prior incidents as [REDACTED] (DOB 07/[REDACTED]/01). [REDACTED] had been the suspect in several prior assaults and disturbance calls in the same area.

I arrived on scene and was flagged down by a subject who stated that his vehicle's mirror was damaged. He pointed to a white ford van that was parked facing westbound on N 45 St. I could see that there was obvious damage to the



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driver's side mirror. The mirror was shattered. The subject reporting the damage to his vehicle was later identified as [REDACTED] (DOB 06/ [REDACTED] /76). [REDACTED] stated that he wanted the incident documented. Witnesses to the incident stated that the suspect who struck the mirror was walking westbound on N 45 St. I turned around and located [REDACTED] near 4501 Interlake Av N.

I exited my vehicle and told [REDACTED] to sit down. [REDACTED] stated he didn't do anything and proceeded to walk northbound on Interlake Av N. I raised my voice and told [REDACTED] to sit down again. [REDACTED] complied and leaned against the wall of the business. I asked [REDACTED] why we had been getting so many calls regarding his activities and he stated he didn't do anything. I noticed that [REDACTED] was bleeding from a finger on his right hand. I asked him if he needed medical aid and he stated no. I provided [REDACTED] an alcohol wipe and band aid. [REDACTED] stated that he always cuts his fingers when he hit people in the face.

I asked [REDACTED] to explain what had happened and he stated the following; [REDACTED] was walking with a group of his friends near N 45 St and Woodlawn Pl N when a subject that he described as, "A fat man" approached [REDACTED] and his friends. The subject cursed at [REDACTED] and told him to get off the sidewalk. [REDACTED] and the subject got in a verbal altercation because [REDACTED] thought that he was being talked down to. A subject driving by then told [REDACTED] to stop yelling and called [REDACTED] a, "Nigger." [REDACTED] then started to argue with the subject driving and the subject struck [REDACTED] in the back of his head. [REDACTED] then struck the subject in the face.

I asked [REDACTED] if he was injured and he stated no. I asked if he wanted to be seen by Seattle Fire Department and he stated no. I asked [REDACTED] if the subject who struck him was still sitting in his car when he punched him and he stated yes. I asked [REDACTED] how the Mirror to the van was broken and he stated he didn't know anything about that.

I asked Officer D. Beard (7459) to re contact the subjects who were standing by at N 45 St and Woodlawn Pl N. Officer T. Poole (8426) stood by with [REDACTED] while I screened the call with Lieutenant Grossman (222) who had arrived on scene.

I re-contacted [REDACTED] and talked to him about that seriousness to the incident as well as the fact that he was the suspect in several other calls.



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[REDACTED] would continually talk about how he was a victim and that people would always try to assault him. I checked the area where [REDACTED] stated he was hit and I noticed no swelling or signs of injury.

Officer Beard arrived back on scene and I asked him if we had probable cause to arrest. Officer Beard informed me that we did and he stated that [REDACTED] had been seen striking the mirror on [REDACTED]'s van. None of the witnesses saw [REDACTED] striking [REDACTED].

I informed [REDACTED] that he was under arrest for property damage. [REDACTED] willing turned around and I placed him in handcuffs. I gaged and double locked the handcuffs. [REDACTED] was searched on ICV and placed into the back of my patrol car. I transported [REDACTED] to the North Precinct and placed him into a holding cell. I called Youth Service Center (YSC) and screened the call with them. YSC declined to take [REDACTED] so I contacted [REDACTED]'s mother [REDACTED]. I advised [REDACTED] of the incident and she agreed to pick up [REDACTED] from the precinct.

When [REDACTED] arrived at the precinct I released [REDACTED] back into her custody. Officer Poole and I talked with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] about the seriousness of the situation that [REDACTED] was in. I provided [REDACTED] a business card with the case number and my information.
